Community Engagement Institute (CEI) 2020 Wrap-Up

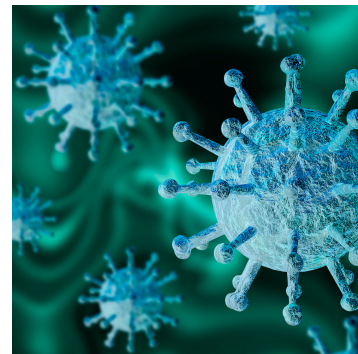
With over 200 participants from across the region, this year's CEI event, *Sharing the Torch: Mobilizing Across Generations*, was a great success!
