

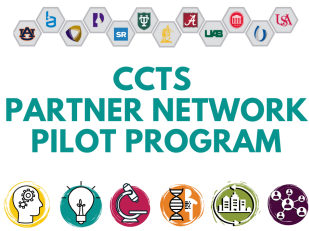

## CCTS PARTNER NETWORK PILOT PROGRAM

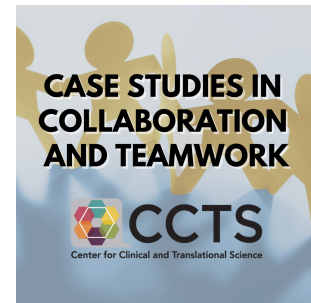
### CCTS Partner Network Pilot Program Accepting Pre-Applications!

New this year, our program invites proposals seeking to overcome barrier(s) in the conduct of research as to minimize or eliminate these issue(s) in subsequent work focused on ameliorating health condition(s) that disproportionately affect our region. Applicants from CCTS Partner Network sites may request up to \$60,000 (direct). Pre-applications are due October 25th.
