TO OUR GUESTS

Welcome to the Fall 2019 Commencement of The University of Alabama at Birmingham. The pageantry of today's ceremony is the culmination and recognition of years of study, preparation, and achievement of our 76th class of graduates. We hope you find the ceremony both meaningful and memorable, as it reflects the combined efforts of the faculty, the staff, and, of course, our students and their families.

Commencement begins with the traditional academic procession. The graduates are led into the Bartow Arena by marshals who are faculty members in their respective college and schools. The faculty, headed by a distinguished group of emeriti professors, follow in order of academic rank and seniority. The last group to enter is the platform party led by the UAB Academic Mace (see page 11). For the Friday evening ceremony, the mace is carried by Karolina M. Mukhtar, Ph.D., associate professor and associate chair in the Department of Biology in the College of Arts and Sciences. She also serves as chair of the Graduate Curriculum Committee. She is a recipient of the 2019 Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers (PECASE) awarded by U.S. President Donald J. Trump, the 2019 UAB President's Award for Excellence in Teaching, and the 2019 CAS Dean's Award for Excellence in Teaching. For the Saturday ceremony, the mace is carried by Gustavo R. Heudebert, M.D., MACP, the recipient of the 2019 Ellen Gregg Ingalls/UAB National Alumni Society Award for Lifetime Achievement in Teaching. Dr. Heudebert serves as professor in the UAB Department of Medicine's Division of General Internal Medicine, Associate Dean of Medical Education in the School of Medicine at UAB, and Interim Dean of the School of Medicine's Montgomery Regional Campus. The Commencement Marshal follows the UAB Academic Mace. Next are Ray L. Watts, M.D., President of The University of Alabama at Birmingham, members of The Board of Trustees of The University of Alabama System, and representatives from The University of Alabama System's Office. Other persons in the platform party include distinguished guests, as well as UAB senior administration and deans.

The audience is asked to stand as the procession enters the arena and to remain standing through the singing of the National Anthem.

President Watts closes the ceremony after all degrees have been awarded and the UAB Alma Mater has been sung. The audience is asked to stand and to remain standing for the recessional of the platform party. Family and friends are asked to meet the new alumni on the concourse or outside of Bartow Arena; they will not be allowed on the arena floor.

Commencement is a festive time for all of our honorees and their guests. Please refrain from loud celebration of your graduate since it detracts from the recognition of the following new alumni. Your cooperation is appreciated.

THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA AT BIRMINGHAM

Since its inception in 1969, the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) has earned international renown for its innovative academic programs, groundbreaking research and scholarship, and leading-edge patient care. The university celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2019 by surpassing a number of significant milestones. UAB was named the top young university in the United States for the second consecutive year — and among the top 12 worldwide — in the Times Higher Education Young University Rankings. UAB also received the Higher Education Excellence in Diversity award from INSIGHT Into Diversity magazine for the third year.

In November, UAB announced a new record total for research funding, with \$602 million in research grants and awards received from November 2018 through October 2019. This was a \$75 million increase compared with 2018; over the past five years, research funding has grown by more than \$154 million. UAB ranks in the top 10 among all public universities in funding from the National Institutes of Health.

With 23,000 employees, UAB is the largest single-site employer in the state of Alabama with an annual economic impact of more than \$7.1 billion. Due to its growing and increasingly residential campus in the heart of a vibrant and diverse community, the university offers unparalleled opportunities for teaching, research, scholarship, and service. The campus consists of more than 150 buildings spread over 100 city blocks within walking distance of downtown Birmingham.

UAB continues to establish innovative academic programs across campus. In the past two years, new bachelor's degrees have launched in Immunology, Genetics and Genomic Sciences, Medical Sociology and Bioinformatics, along with master's degree programs in Data Science and Engineering Management. Bachelor's degrees in Entrepreneurship and Cancer Biology, along with a doctoral program in Neuro-engineering, are in development.

The UAB Honors College provides enhanced experiential learning opportunities to more than 2,000 high-ability undergraduates. In the 2020 U.S. News & World Report "Best Graduate Schools" rankings, UAB has 14 programs in the top 25, including a master's in health administration program that ranks first in the nation.

UAB is home to the largest hospital in Alabama and one of the largest public hospitals in the United States. Last year, UAB and Children's of Alabama treated more patients than ever: more than 1.7 million. UAB also houses the state's only level 1 adult trauma center and the O'Neal Comprehensive Cancer Center, the only National Cancer Institute-designated comprehensive cancer center in Alabama. The Comprehensive Transplant Institute, which has performed the second most kidney transplants in the history of medicine, is currently conducting the longest-ever kidney transplant chain at a single site.

UAB continues to attract the best and brightest students from Alabama, the nation, and around the world. UAB's international students, faculty, staff, and visiting scholars represent more than 100 countries. The university welcomed 2,346 freshmen in fall 2019, its largest freshman class and part of a student population that passed 22,000 for the first time. That marks the fourth straight year of record enrollment.

UAB ALMA MATER

The UAB Alma Mater was composed by Birmingham native David McNeeley in 2003. A competition was held, and a committee comprising UAB faculty, administrators, students, and alumni selected it from numerous submissions. The Alma Mater expresses the unifying sentiments of pride, respect, and cherished memories for the university.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The custom of wearing academic caps, gowns, and hoods can be traced to the twelfth century. At that time both men and women wore long, full, flowing robes. This mode of dress gradually changed so that by the end of the seventeenth century only legal and official personages wore gowns. However, certain guilds and universities established the tradition of wearing prescribed apparel. In the universities, the details of the dress distinguished different degrees of learning and the faculty. In the United States, as a result of our English heritage, caps and gowns have been used from colonial times, especially at our older universities such as Columbia (King's College), New York University, University of Pennsylvania, Bryn Mawr, Yale, and others. Around 1885 there was a widespread student movement to wear caps and gowns at commencement. The faculties approved this dignified graduation dress and soon adopted the custom of wearing gowns at academic ceremonies.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission presented American institutions of higher learning the Intercollegiate Code. This code regulated the design of gowns and hoods as well as the colors and materials to be used. The code was subsequently adopted by more than 95 percent of U.S. colleges and universities. It has given America an impressive but simple method of signifying scholastic honors.

The code provides for three types of gowns. The gown for the bachelor's degree is made of green material and has long pointed sleeves. The gown for the master's degree is made with an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of this oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced with velvet and has three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The color of the velvet trim may be black or the same color as the velvet which edges the gown.

The green oxford or mortarboard-style cap is worn for all degrees, but only the doctor's cap may be made of velvet and have a gold tassel.

The hood is the most important and distinctive feature of the American code. An understanding of the system makes it possible to distinguish readily bachelor's, master's, and doctor's hoods and to recognize the university which gave the degree. The doctor's hood is four feet in length and made with a wide panel. The master's and bachelor's hoods are three and one-half and three feet in length, respectively. They are made of black cloth and are lined with silk in the official academic colors of the institution which conferred the degree. The hoods worn by graduates of The University of Alabama at Birmingham are lined in green silk with a gold chevron. The trim of all hoods is velvet, two inches, three inches, and five inches wide for bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees, respectively. The color of the velvet trim indicates the discipline or faculty to which the degree pertains. Each discipline has been assigned a different color by the Intercollegiate Code. The following is a list of colors assigned to several of the disciplines within The University of Alabama at Birmingham.

A few years ago some Ivy League colleges approved the wearing of gowns which were not black but the official school colors. This trend has expanded so that currently many colleges and universities have adopted special colored gowns. The members of The Board of Trustees of The University of Alabama system wear a green gown with gold trim at The University of Alabama at Birmingham academic ceremonies. Colored gowns worn by many faculty identify the doctoral degrees of many American and foreign universities.

THE CEREMONIAL ACADEMIC MACE

The ceremonial academic mace appeared in European universities during the fourteenth century and represented the amalgamation of two much older staff-like devices of similar length and shape. These were the regal scepter and the medieval battle mace. Kings throughout history have carried scepters as insignia of the lawful authority of just rulers. The battle mace was first used by medieval princes as an effective hand weapon in combat.

In the fourteenth century, the royal scepter and the battle mace were combined to produce the ceremonial academic mace. It was carried before royalty, mayors of cities, and chief officers of the medieval universities.

In modern times, the mace is used on ceremonial occasions in the life of the university. In commencement exercises, the mace specifically indicates the authority of the university president to award degrees. The mace immediately precedes the presidential party in the ceremonial procession. For the Friday evening ceremony, the mace is carried by Karolina M. Dr. Heudebert serves as professor in the UAB Department of Medicine's Division of General Internal Medicine, Associate Dean of Medical Education in the School of Medicine at UAB, and Interim Dean of the School of Medicine's Montgomery Regional Campus.

The UAB mace is fashioned in three metals: brass, bronze, and stainless steel. The use of these metals--especially the stainless steel--is intended to signify Birmingham's traditional role as an iron and steel producing center.

At the lower end of the mace are three medallions of enamel on copper. One medallion bears the image of the lamp of knowledge. Another bears the traditional symbol of the physician, the Caduceus (Aesculapius, Greco-Roman god of medicine, was embodied at the temple of Kos as a statue holding a serpent, a symbol of long life, healing, and knowledge. A staff and a second serpent were added later to form the Caduceus). The third medallion is the UAB logo in gold on a green enamel background with a red enamel glow on the collar to symbolize the molten metal characteristic of old Birmingham and its blast furnaces.

The UAB mace and its holder were commissioned, designed, and executed in 1989 by the noted Alabama sculptor, Cordray Parker, with the help of Heidi J. Bowman on the enameled medallions. The mace was made possible through the generosity of the late Samuel B. Barker, Ph.D., and his late wife, Justine. Dr. Barker, distinguished professor emeritus and dean emeritus of UAB, was the first dean of the UAB Graduate School and a leading patron of the arts in Birmingham.

THE ACADEMIC GONFALONS

The academic gonfalons feature the UAB logo, the university seal and the name of the schools in white on a background of black, in keeping with the traditional black academic gowns worn by students and faculty. Each gonfalon also features a border of the school's academic color, which is repeated across the entire back of the banner. The exception is the UAB gonfalon, which features white letters on a green background, bordered and backed in gold, denoting UAB's official colors.

THE UAB PRESIDENT'S MEDAL

The UAB President's Medal is designed to recognize individuals who have attained scholarly distinction and/or have rendered distinguished service to UAB. Recipients are selected by the President of UAB upon the advice and recommendation of senior university officials. The award is comprised of an antique brass medallion and plaque, suitably inscribed, mounted in a cherry stand. The UAB President's Medal is awarded at a commencement ceremony.

2019 RECIPIENT OF THE UAB PRESIDENT'S MEDAL

Richard C. Shelby, U.S. Senator

Citation Excerpts Read by Ray L. Watts, M.D., President

Richard C. Shelby, the longest serving United States Senator from Alabama and Chairman of the Senate Committee on Appropriations, is a dedicated and accomplished statesman who is widely respected throughout Alabama and our nation.

A fifth generation Alabamian and Birmingham native, Senator Shelby earned his B.A. from The University of Alabama and his Bachelor of Laws degree from The University of Alabama School of Law. After graduation, he served for eight years as Tuscaloosa City Prosecutor, four years as U.S. Magistrate for the Northern District of Alabama, and three years as Special Assistant Attorney General of Alabama. In 1970, he was elected as an Alabama State Senator and, in 1979, a U.S. Representative. He was elected to the U.S. Senate in 1987 and is now in his sixth term.

Senator Shelby is currently chair of the Senate Committee on Appropriations and serves on the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works. Formerly he chaired the Senate Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs Committee and the Senate Committee on Rules and Administration, and remains a senior member on those committees. Senator Shelby is one of only a few members to have chaired four committees while in office, having also chaired the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence early in his career. These and other roles in the Senate reflect more than the three decades of highly respected and influential leadership on behalf of the people of this state.

Senator Shelby's longtime advocacy of federally funded research is improving the lives of every Alabamian. With his support, the leading-edge research conducted at UAB and other leading universities continues to have a profound impact—on health and quality of life, educational opportunity, technology and economic development—across Alabama and the U.S. In FY2018 research awards at UAB grew by 10 percent (\$48 million) to a record \$527 million, and UAB is among only eight universities nationally whose funding from the National Institutes of Health has increased by more than \$100 million over the past five years.

As a champion for such federal investment in research, Senator Shelby is not only helping countless patients and their families, but also helping grow our economy locally and nationally. The Richard C. and Annette N. Shelby Interdisciplinary Biomedical Research Building, UAB's largest research facility, increased research space by 25 percent when it opened in 2006. It is home to scores of faculty and staff whose activities contribute to UAB's 62 percent growth in research expenditures in the twelve years since the opening. This is part of a UAB's globally competitive research enterprise that contributes to an overall economic impact of \$7.15 billion annually on the state of Alabama.

These and other accomplishments speak to Senator Shelby's strong and visionary leadership in Congress and his effectiveness in collaborating with higher education, industry and other constituencies statewide. Those productive partnerships he has helped forge continue to advance vital shared aims: improved health, education and economic development throughout Alabama and the nation, and restored American preeminence in science and technology around the globe.

In recognition of his extraordinary service to UAB and our community, the state of Alabama, and our nation, The University of Alabama at Birmingham is privileged to confer upon Senator Richard C. Shelby the 2019 President's Medal.

An undergraduate student graduating with Summa, Magna, or Cum Laude honors is also accorded the privilege of wearing a gold honors cord.

The UAB Honors College brings together high-achieving intellectually curious students from all majors to form a close-knit community of emerging scholars. Honors students may follow a personalized curriculum or specialize in global and community leadership (GCL), science and technology (STH), or interdisciplinary arts and sciences (UHP). Honors students are recognized with “distinguished honors” for earning 18 hours of honors credit and “high distinguished honors” for 30 or more hours of honors credits. Students completing honors requirements wear a white cord and a UAB Honors College medallion.

School of Dentistry – The “With Honors” designation indicates at least a B average, completion of an approved plan of study and research, and completion of a relevant thesis.

Schools of Medicine and Optometry – Honors are given to those in the upper ten percent of their class based on overall grade point average. The designation Magna Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude are not routinely awarded. Any graduate receiving such a designation is outstanding in ability and performance.
