## TO OUR GUESTS

Welcome to the Fall 2021 Commencement of The University of Alabama at Birmingham. The pageantry of today's ceremony is the culmination and recognition of years of study, preparation, and achievement of our 82nd class of graduates. We hope you find the ceremony both meaningful and memorable, as it reflects the combined efforts of the faculty, the staff, and, of course, our students and their families.

Commencement begins with the traditional academic procession. The graduates are led into Bartow Arena by marshals who are faculty members in their respective college and schools. The faculty, headed by a distinguished group of emeriti professors, follow in order of academic rank and seniority. The last group to enter is the platform party led by the UAB Academic Mace (see page 12). For the Friday evening ceremony, the mace is carried by Steven N. Austad, Ph.D., Distinguished Professor and Chair of the Department of Biology. He is a recipient of the 2020 Caroline P. and Charles W. Ireland Prize for Scholarly Distinction. Dr. Austad also co-directs one of only eight Nathan Shock Centers of Excellence in the nation funded by the National Institute on Aging. Dr. Austad's research includes mitochondrial function, protein stability, and stress resistance as they affect aging. One of his studies involves clams that live over 500 years as models for healthy aging. An interesting offshoot of that study is that these long-lived clams may contain chemicals that could help prevent or treat Alzheimer's disease and other conditions caused by unwanted aggregations of misfolded proteins. His lab also investigates why such diseases and conditions often affect one sex more than the other. For the Saturday morning ceremony, the mace is carried by Sylvie Mrug, Ph.D., University Professor and Chair of the Department of Psychology. She is the recipient of the 2021 Caroline P. and Charles W. Ireland Prize for Scholarly Distinction. She was the recipient of the 2018 UAB Graduate Dean's Award for Excellence in Mentorship and the 2012 President's Award for Excellence in Teaching. Dr. Mrug's research examines the interplay of risk and protective factors in the development of behavioral and emotional problems in adolescence, including antisocial behavior, substance use, depression and anxiety with specific focus on the effects of violence exposure and peer influences in conjunction with other individual and contextual risk factors, such as pubertal timing, temperament, stress reactivity, parental practices, and broader influences of schools and neighborhoods. For the Saturday afternoon ceremony, the mace is carried by Gregg H. Gilbert, DDS, MBA, the 2019 Distinguished Faculty Lecturer. Dr. Gilbert serves as Distinguished Professor and Chair in the UAB Department of Clinical and Community Sciences in the School of Dentistry. Dr. Gilbert secured a \$66M grant, the largest in UAB history, from the National Institutes of Health to create The National Dental Practice-Based Research Network that includes six regional centers and more than 6,000 practitioners who are improving each step of the research process by generating new ideas, developing studies, performing field testing, collecting data and then presenting and publishing their findings—a hallmark of the network's success. Next are Ray L. Watts, M.D., President of The University of Alabama at Birmingham, members of The Board of Trustees of The University of Alabama System, and representatives from The University of Alabama System's Office. Other persons in the platform party include distinguished guests, as well as UAB senior administration and deans.

The audience is asked to stand as the procession enters the arena and to remain standing through the singing of the National Anthem.

President Watts closes the ceremony after all degrees have been awarded and the UAB Alma Mater has been sung. The audience is asked to stand and to remain standing for the recessional of the platform party. Family and friends are asked to meet the new alumni outside of Bartow Arena; they will not be allowed on the arena floor.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA AT BIRMINGHAM

Over the five decades since its founding in 1969, the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) has earned international renown for its innovative academic programs, groundbreaking research and scholarship, and leading-edge patient care. Throughout the global pandemic, UAB has played a leading role in combatting COVID-19 nationally and globally, treating more than 5,400 COVID patients, administering more than 266,000 vaccinations, and participating in a number of clinical trials for potential treatments and vaccines. At the same time, the university has continued making record-breaking strides in all pillars of its mission, despite the pandemic.

This fall UAB enrolled the largest and most diverse freshman class in university history: 2,415 students, with 45.4 percent coming from underrepresented groups and 28 percent of the class the first in their families to go to college. The average ACT score for first-time freshmen was 26.5 and the average GPA was 3.82. For the fourth straight year, *Insight into Diversity* magazine named UAB one of its Diversity Champions (among only 14 universities nationally). A record 80 percent of freshmen lived on campus in fall 2021. The Honors College also reported record total enrollment of 2,590 students.

UAB is currently implementing its new Signature Core Curriculum, now known as Blazer Core, a 21st century undergraduate curriculum focused on experiential learning in the real world that effectively equips students to think critically and collaborate on solutions to local and global challenges. In the 2022 U.S. News & World Report “Best Graduate Schools” rankings, UAB has 16 programs in the top 25, including a Master’s in Health Administration program that ranks first in the nation.

Students and their faculty mentors are engaged in a robust research enterprise that is more competitive than ever. In FY2021, research awards surpassed \$838 million, marking the most successful five-year period of research funding in the university's history, with an increase of \$385 million (85 percent) from 2016 to 2021. Among public universities, UAB ranks 15th in federal research funding and 8th in funding from the National Institutes of Health (NIH), with all UAB health-related schools ranked among the top 10 in NIH funding among public universities. The School of Medicine will be even more competitive thanks to the single largest philanthropic commitment in university history, a \$100-million investment announced in fall 2021 that establishes the UAB Marnix E. Heersink School of Medicine.

This research is being translated into world-class patient care, as UAB — the nation's 11th largest hospital and fourth largest public hospital — was again ranked by U.S. News & World Report as the best hospital in Alabama, with eight adult specialties ranked among the nation's best. UAB Hospital earned Magnet Designation for Nursing Excellence for the fifth straight time, among only 21 hospitals worldwide to achieve this recognition. UAB houses the state's only level 1 adult trauma center and the O'Neal Comprehensive Cancer Center, the only National Cancer Institute-designated comprehensive cancer center in Alabama.

With more than 23,000 employees and spanning 100 city blocks, UAB is the largest single-site employer in Alabama, with a statewide economic impact of \$7.1 billion annually. Forbes recently ranked UAB number one on its list of Best Large Employers (above the likes of Mayo Clinic, NASA and Google) and the Best Employer for Diversity among colleges and universities.

## UAB ALMA MATER

The UAB Alma Mater was composed by Birmingham native David McNeeley in 2003. A competition was held, and a committee comprising UAB faculty, administrators, students, and alumni selected it from numerous submissions. The Alma Mater expresses the unifying sentiments of pride, respect, and cherished memories for the university.

## THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The custom of wearing academic caps, gowns, and hoods can be traced to the twelfth century. At that time both men and women wore long, full, flowing robes. This mode of dress gradually changed so that by the end of the seventeenth century only legal and official personages wore gowns. However, certain guilds and universities established the tradition of wearing prescribed apparel. In the universities, the details of the dress distinguished different degrees of learning and the faculty. In the United States, as a result of our English heritage, caps and gowns have been used from colonial times, especially at our older universities such as Columbia (King's College), New York University, University of Pennsylvania, Bryn Mawr, Yale, and others. Around 1885 there was a widespread student movement to wear caps and gowns at commencement. The faculties approved this dignified graduation dress and soon adopted the custom of wearing gowns at academic ceremonies.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission presented American institutions of higher learning the Intercollegiate Code. This code regulated the design of gowns and hoods as well as the colors and materials to be used. The code was subsequently adopted by more than 95 percent of U.S. colleges and universities. It has given America an impressive but simple method of signifying scholastic honors.

The code provides for three types of gowns. The gown for the bachelor's degree is made of green material and has long pointed sleeves. The gown for the master's degree is made with an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of this oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced with velvet and has three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The color of the velvet trim may be black or the same color as the velvet which edges the gown.

The green oxford or mortarboard-style cap is worn for all degrees, but only the doctor's cap may be made of velvet and have a gold tassel.

The hood is the most important and distinctive feature of the American code. An understanding of the system makes it possible to distinguish readily bachelor's, master's, and doctor's hoods and to recognize the university which gave the degree. The doctor's hood is four feet in length and made with a wide panel. The master's and bachelor's hoods are three and one-half and three feet in length, respectively. They are made of black cloth and are lined with silk in the official academic colors of the institution which conferred the degree. The hoods worn by graduates of The University of Alabama at Birmingham are lined in green silk with a gold chevron. The trim of all hoods is velvet, two inches, three inches, and five inches wide for bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees, respectively. The color of the velvet trim indicates the discipline or faculty to which the degree pertains. Each discipline has been assigned a different color by the Intercollegiate Code. The following is a list of colors assigned to several of the disciplines within The University of Alabama at Birmingham.

A few years ago some Ivy League colleges approved the wearing of gowns which were not black but the official school colors. This trend has expanded so that currently many colleges and universities have adopted special colored gowns. The members of The Board of Trustees of The University of Alabama system wear a green gown with gold trim at The University of Alabama at Birmingham academic ceremonies. Colored gowns worn by many faculty identify the doctoral degrees of many American and foreign universities.

## THE CEREMONIAL ACADEMIC MACE

The ceremonial academic mace appeared in European universities during the fourteenth century and represented the amalgamation of two much older staff-like devices of similar length and shape. These were the regal scepter and the medieval battle mace. Kings throughout history have carried scepters as insignia of the lawful authority of just rulers. The battle mace was first used by medieval princes as an effective hand weapon in combat.

In the fourteenth century, the royal scepter and the battle mace were combined to produce the ceremonial academic mace. It was carried before royalty, mayors of cities, and chief officers of the medieval universities.

In modern times, the mace is used on ceremonial occasions in the life of the university. In commencement exercises, the mace specifically indicates the authority of the university president to award degrees. The mace immediately precedes the presidential party in the ceremonial procession. For the Friday evening ceremony, the mace is carried by Steven N. Dr. Gilbert secured a \$66M grant, the largest in UAB history, from the National Institutes of Health to create The National Dental Practice-Based Research Network that includes six regional centers and more than 6,000 practitioners who are improving each step of the research process by generating new ideas, developing studies, performing field testing, collecting data and then presenting and publishing their findings—a hallmark of the network's success.

The UAB mace is fashioned in three metals: brass, bronze, and stainless steel. The use of these metals--especially the stainless steel--is intended to signify Birmingham's traditional role as an iron and steel producing center.

At the lower end of the mace are three medallions of enamel on copper. One medallion bears the image of the lamp of knowledge. Another bears the traditional symbol of the physician, the Caduceus (Aesculapius, Greco-Roman god of medicine, was embodied at the temple of Kos as a statue holding a serpent, a symbol of long life, healing, and knowledge. A staff and a second serpent were added later to form the Caduceus). The third medallion is the UAB logo in gold on a green enamel background with a red enamel glow.

on the collar to symbolize the molten metal characteristic of old Birmingham and its blast furnaces.

The UAB mace was commissioned, designed, and executed in 1989 by the noted Alabama sculptor, Cordray Parker, with the help of Heidi J. Bowman on the enameled medallions. In 2021, Jamey Worrell, Ph.D., professor of accounting in the Collat School of Business, handcrafted a new stand for the mace. He sourced lumber from felled trees on UAB's campus and around Birmingham, selecting wood that represents some of the university's best qualities: oak for strength, hickory for resiliency, elm for knowledge, and cherry for passion.

The mace was made possible through the generosity of the late Samuel B. Barker, Ph.D., and his late wife, Justine. Dr. Barker, distinguished professor emeritus and dean emeritus of UAB, was the first dean of the UAB Graduate School and a leading patron of the arts in Birmingham.

## **THE ACADEMIC GONFALONS**

The academic gonfalons feature the UAB logo, the university seal and the name of the schools in white on a background of black, in keeping with the traditional black academic gowns worn by students and faculty. Each gonfalon also features a border of the school's academic color, which is repeated across the entire back of the banner. The exception is the UAB gonfalon, which features white letters on a green background, bordered and backed in gold, denoting UAB's official colors.

## **THE UAB PRESIDENT'S MEDAL**

**The UAB Honors College** brings together high-achieving intellectually curious students from all majors to form a close-knit community of emerging scholars. Honors students may follow a personalized curriculum or specialize in global and community leadership (GCL), science and technology (STH), or interdisciplinary arts and sciences (UHP). Honors students are recognized with “distinguished honors” for earning 18 hours of honors credit and “high distinguished honors” for 30 or more hours of honors credits. Students completing honors requirements wear a white cord and a UAB Honors College medallion.

**School of Dentistry** – The “With Honors” designation indicates at least a B average, completion of an approved plan of study and research, and completion of a relevant thesis.

**Schools of Medicine and Optometry** – Honors are given to those in the upper ten percent of their class based on overall grade point average. The designation Magna Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude are not routinely awarded. Any graduate receiving such a designation is outstanding in ability and performance.
