# THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA AT BIRMINGHAM

Over the five-plus decades since it was founded in 1969, the University of Alabama at Birmingham has earned international renown for its innovative academic programs, groundbreaking research and scholarship, and leading-edge patient care. In the 2024-2025 U.S. News & World Report “Best Global Universities” rankings, which focus on academic research and overall reputation, UAB was in the top 7 percent globally.

In fall 2024, 34 percent of UAB’s freshman class were first-generation students. The average ACT score for all first-time freshmen was 26.5 and the average GPA was 3.77.

The fall 2024 semester saw UAB continue to expand its Blazer Core Curriculum, introduced in 2023. This 21st century undergraduate curriculum is focused on experiential learning in the real world that effectively equips students to think critically and collaborate on solutions to local and global challenges. There are now 212 courses offered as part of the Blazer Core Curriculum in eight UAB schools and 26 departments, including 30 City as a Classroom courses, which are a signature part of the curriculum.

In the 2025 U.S. News & World Report “Best Graduate Schools” rankings, UAB had 19 programs in the top 25, including a Master’s in Health Administration program that ranks first in the nation and 10 programs in the top 10.

Students and their faculty mentors are engaged in a research enterprise that continues to expand. In fiscal year 2023, UAB’s research expenditures reached a record \$780 million, extending the most successful era of research funding growth in the university’s history. Over the past decade, research funding has grown by 82 percent. Among public universities, UAB ranks 21st in federal research funding and 13th in funding from the National Institutes of Health (NIH).

In order to build on that momentum, UAB launched its Strategic Research Initiative: Growth with Purpose in 2023 with the bold goal of substantially increasing its impact on people’s lives by reaching \$1 billion in research expenditures by 2030.

The School of Health Professions (second), School of Nursing (fourth), and School of Optometry (fifth), are all in the top 10 nationally in NIH funding, and all six UAB health-related schools are in the top 20 among public universities in NIH funding. This research is being translated into commercialization success through the Harbert Institute for Innovation and Entrepreneurship. In fiscal year 2024, the institute generated \$6.5 million in revenues and launched five startups.

UAB’s research is also being translated into world-class patient care. UAB Hospital — the nation’s eighth largest hospital — was again ranked by U.S. News & World Report as the best hospital in Alabama in its 2024-2025 list, with seven adult specialties ranked among the nation’s best. To meet a 20 percent volume increase over the past five years, the emergency department has launched a \$73 million expansion that includes \$50 million in state support. And on Nov. 1, 2024, the UAB Health System Authority officially assumed ownership of the Ascension St. Vincent’s Health System in central Alabama.

With more than 28,000 employees and a campus spanning more than 105 city blocks, UAB is the largest single-site employer in Alabama, with a statewide economic impact of \$12.1 billion annually in fiscal year 2022, up from \$7.15 billion in fiscal year 2016. In 2021, Forbes ranked UAB number one on its list of Best Large Employers (above the likes of Mayo Clinic, NASA, and Google).

# UAB ALMA MATER

The UAB Alma Mater was composed by Birmingham native David McNeeley in 2003. A competition was held, and a committee comprising UAB faculty, administrators, students, and alumni selected it from numerous submissions. The Alma Mater expresses the unifying sentiments of pride, respect, and cherished memories for the university.

## THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The custom of wearing academic caps, gowns, and hoods can be traced to the twelfth century. At that time both men and women wore long, full, flowing robes. This mode of dress gradually changed so that by the end of the seventeenth century only legal and official personages wore gowns. However, certain guilds and universities established the tradition of wearing prescribed apparel. In the universities, the details of the dress distinguished different degrees of learning and the faculty. In the United States, as a result of our English heritage, caps and gowns have been used from colonial times, especially at our older universities such as Columbia (King's College), New York University, University of Pennsylvania, Bryn Mawr, Yale, and others. Around 1885 there was a widespread student movement to wear caps and gowns at commencement. The faculties approved this dignified graduation dress and soon adopted the custom of wearing gowns at academic ceremonies.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission presented American institutions of higher learning the Intercollegiate Code. This code regulated the design of gowns and hoods as well as the colors and materials to be used. The code was subsequently adopted by more than 95 percent of U.S. colleges and universities. It has given America an impressive but simple method of signifying scholastic honors.

The code provides for three types of gowns. The gown for the bachelor's degree is made of green material and has long pointed sleeves. The gown for the master's degree is made with an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of this oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced with velvet and has three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The color of the velvet trim may be black or the same color as the velvet which edges the gown.

The green oxford or mortarboard-style cap is worn for all degrees, but only the doctor's cap may be made of velvet and have a gold tassel.

The hood is the most important and distinctive feature of the American code. An understanding of the system makes it possible to distinguish readily bachelor's, master's, and doctor's hoods and to recognize the university which gave the degree. The doctor's hood is four feet in length and made with a wide panel. The master's and bachelor's hoods are three and one-half and three feet in length, respectively. They are made of black cloth and are lined with silk in the official academic colors of the institution which conferred the degree. The hoods worn by graduates of The University of Alabama at Birmingham are lined in green silk with a gold chevron. The trim of all hoods is velvet, two inches, three inches, and five inches wide for bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees, respectively. The color of the velvet trim indicates the discipline or faculty to which the degree pertains. Each discipline has been assigned a different color by the Intercollegiate Code. The following is a list of colors assigned to several of the disciplines within The University of Alabama at Birmingham.

A few years ago some Ivy League colleges approved the wearing of gowns which were not black but the official school colors. This trend has expanded so that currently many colleges and universities have adopted special colored gowns. The members of The Board of Trustees of The University of Alabama system wear a green gown with gold trim at The University of Alabama at Birmingham academic ceremonies. Colored gowns worn by many faculty identify the doctoral degrees of many American and foreign universities.

## THE CEREMONIAL ACADEMIC MACE

The ceremonial academic mace appeared in European universities during the fourteenth century and represented the amalgamation of two much older staff-like devices of similar length and shape. These were the regal scepter and the medieval battle mace. Kings throughout history have carried scepters as insignia of the lawful authority of just rulers. The battle mace was first used by medieval princes as an effective hand weapon in combat.

In the fourteenth century, the royal scepter and the battle mace were combined to produce the ceremonial academic mace. It was carried before royalty, mayors of cities, and chief officers of the medieval universities.

In modern times, the mace is used on ceremonial occasions in the life of the university. In commencement exercises, the mace specifically indicates the authority of the university president to award degrees. The mace immediately precedes the presidential party in the ceremonial procession. For the Commencement ceremonies, the mace is carried by Joe L. March, Ph.D., Professor of Chemistry and Associate Director of the Science and Technology Honors Program.

The UAB mace is fashioned in three metals: brass, bronze, and stainless steel. The use of these metals--especially the stainless steel--is intended to signify Birmingham's traditional role as an iron and steel producing center.

At the lower end of the mace are three medallions of enamel on copper. One medallion bears the image of the lamp of knowledge. Another bears the traditional symbol of the physician, the Caduceus (Aesculapius, Greco-Roman god of medicine, was embodied at the temple of Kos as a statue holding a serpent, a symbol of long life, healing, and knowledge. A staff and a second serpent were added later to form the Caduceus). The third medallion is the UAB logo in gold on a green enamel background with a red enamel glow on the collar to symbolize the molten metal characteristic of old Birmingham and its blast furnaces.

The UAB mace was commissioned, designed, and executed in 1989 by the noted Alabama sculptor, Cordray Parker, with the help of Heidi J. Bowman on the enameled medallions. In 2021, Jamey Worrell, Ph.D., professor of accounting in the Collat School of Business, handcrafted a new stand for the mace. He sourced lumber from felled trees on UAB's campus and around Birmingham, selecting wood that represents some of the university's best qualities: oak for strength, hickory for resiliency, elm for knowledge, and cherry for passion.

The mace was made possible through the generosity of the late Samuel B. Barker, Ph.D., and his late wife, Justine. Dr. Barker, distinguished professor emeritus and dean emeritus of UAB, was the first dean of the UAB Graduate School and a leading patron of the arts in Birmingham.

## **THE ACADEMIC GONFALONS**

The academic gonfalons feature the UAB logo, the university seal and the name of the schools in white on a background of black, in keeping with the traditional black academic gowns worn by students and faculty. Each gonfalon also features a border of the school's academic color, which is repeated across the entire back of the banner. The exception is the UAB gonfalon, which features white letters on a green background, bordered and backed in gold, denoting UAB's official colors.

## THE UAB PRESIDENT'S MEDAL

The UAB President's Medal is designed to recognize individuals who have attained scholarly distinction and/or have rendered distinguished service to UAB. Recipients are selected by the President of UAB upon the advice and recommendation of senior university officials. Selection as the recipient of this medal is one of the highest honors bestowed by UAB.

The award is comprised of an antique brass medallion and plaque, suitably inscribed, mounted in a cherry stand. The UAB President's Medal is awarded at a commencement ceremony.

## **2024 RECIPIENT OF THE UAB PRESIDENT’S MEDAL**

Dr. Marnix E. Heersink is an eye surgeon, innovator, entrepreneur and philanthropist. Dr. Heersink and his wife of 46 years, Mary Parks Heersink, have for decades supported numerous organizations and initiatives aimed at improving health, education, and economic development throughout Alabama and well beyond. Their efforts have forged strong partnerships in research, patient care, and education among leading universities, medical centers, and nations, particularly between the United States, Canada, and the Netherlands.

In 2021 and 2022, the Heersinks made transformational commitments to UAB totaling \$100 million—the largest philanthropic commitments in the university’s history—that fittingly named the UAB Marnix E. Heersink School of Medicine (HSOM) and established the Marnix E. Heersink Institute for Biomedical Innovation, the Mary Heersink Institute for Global Health, a new conference center, and a number of supporting endowments. In keeping with Heersinks’ vision, this historic gift has been used to enhance and accelerate critical initiatives in the HSOM, including leading-edge biomedical innovation in strategic priority areas, recruitment and retention of top faculty, and growth of international partnerships in global health. The Heersink Family also made a substantial financial commitment to McMaster University in Ontario, Canada, with whom UAB now has a promising research partnership in key focus areas.

The Heersinks have made several other important investments in UAB, including the Heersink Family Endowed Ophthalmologic Glaucoma Fellowship; the Heersink Family Foundation Scholarship Endowment in Optometry; the Heersink Family Foundation Endowed Scholarship in Health Professions; the Heersink Wiregrass Pathway to Optometry Endowed Scholarships; and the Heersink Family Optometric Scholarship Endowment. The Heersink Family Foundation made a generous commitment to support the renovation and construction of the Heersink Family Active Learning Resource Center, consisting of the atrium, flip classroom, and study rooms in Volker Hall—the centerpiece of medical education at UAB. Additionally, Dr. Heersink’s leadership has been central to the opening of UAB School of Dentistry’s first satellite clinic, UAB Dentistry Dothan, a first-of-its-kind facility aimed at improving dental health in the Wiregrass region, advancing dental research, and training dental students for rural practice.

Beyond UAB, the Heersinks have provided support and service to many other organizations including the Boy Scouts of America; the Netherland-America Foundation; the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind; Boys and Girls Club of Alabama; the Wiregrass Museum of Art; and Houston Academy.

Dr. Heersink graduated magna cum laude from the University of Western Ontario (Canada), where he earned both bachelor’s and medical degrees. He then completed his internship at the Royal Victoria Hospital in Montreal, Canada, and his residency in ophthalmology as well as a fellowship in cataract surgery and intraocular lens implantation at Wills Eye Hospital in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Following his medical training, Dr. and Mrs. Heersink moved to Dothan, Alabama, where he co-founded Eye Center South in 1980, which now has 12 locations in Alabama, Florida, and Georgia. The flagship facility, through thoughtful planning and design, was renovated and expanded to form the campus of Health Center South, which is now home to several thriving businesses and provides comprehensive general eye care as well as specialty surgical eye care at Alabama’s first and top-ranked outpatient surgical center.

Dr. Heersink with his partner, Frank Barefield, also established Abbey Residential a highly successful multifamily real estate business in 1984.

Dr. Heersink is certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and American Board of Eye Surgery and is a member of numerous professional organizations including the International College of Surgeons; the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons; the American Academy of Ophthalmology; American College of Surgeons; the Medical Association of the State of Alabama; and the Houston County Medical Society. Mary Heersink serves on the HSOM Board of Visitors and on the Advisory Board of the Master of Global Health Program, a joint initiative among several international universities. She authored “E. coli 0157: The True Story of a Mother’s Battle with a Killer Microbe” after the Heersinks’ then 11-year-old son Damion nearly died from E. coli in the early 1990s, and she has since been a leading advocate for federal oversight and regulations, co-founding STOP Foodborne Illness, a national food safety organization on whose board of directors she still serves.

The Heersinks have six adult children, all of whom are engaged in medical and dental careers. Christiaan is an HSOM graduate who now is a resident at Huntsville Hospital; his twin brother, Marius, is an HSOM graduate, and he and brother Sebastian are now practicing ophthalmologists in Dothan, working alongside their father; Mila Heersink Jacoba is an HSOM graduate and practicing ophthalmologist in Minnesota; Bayne is a UAB School of Dentistry graduate now practicing and residing in Dothan (along with his wife, Juanita Titrud Heersink, an HSOM graduate and former Miss UAB); and Damion is both a licensed U.S. patent attorney and a practicing internal medicine doctor with Ochsner Health System in New Orleans, Louisiana. The Heersinks have 11 grandchildren.

In recognition of his extraordinary vision, leadership, and generosity to UAB and the state of Alabama, The University of Alabama at Birmingham is privileged to confer upon Marnix E. Heersink, M.D., the 2024 UAB President’s Medal.

**The UAB Honors College** brings together high-achieving intellectually curious students from all majors to form a close-knit community of emerging scholars. Honors students may follow a personalized curriculum or specialize in global and community leadership (GCL), science and technology (STH), or interdisciplinary arts and sciences (UHP). Honors students are recognized with “distinguished honors” for earning 18 hours of honors credit and “high distinguished honors” for 30 or more hours of honors credits. Students completing honors requirements wear a white cord and a UAB Honors College medallion.

**School of Dentistry** – The “With Honors” designation indicates at least a B average, completion of an approved plan of study and research, and completion of a relevant thesis.

**Schools of Medicine and Optometry** – Honors are given to those in the upper ten percent of their class based on overall grade point average. The designation Magna Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude are not routinely awarded. Any graduate receiving such a designation is outstanding in ability and performance.
