Additionally, the applicant must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have a minimum of three full years of full-time, acceptable, professional educational experience in a P-12 setting, which must include one full year of full-time, P-12 classroom teaching experience; Successfully pass an admissions portfolio and interview; and Meet all requirements for admission to the UAB Graduate School. Applicants who hold a valid Alabama Class A certificate in library media or school counseling that have been employed full-time in the same school district for seven full years, please contact the UAB School of Education Office of Student Services (call 205-934-7530) for Option 2 unconditional admission requirements.	Notes: Candidates may not take any courses with an EDL course prefix leading to certification prior to unconditional admission to the Instructional Leadership Program.
