

Assurance of Support for Applicant Form

The UAB School Psychology Online Program provides a pathway for PK-12 educators to earn an Educational Specialist (Ed.S.) in School Psychology while employed with a school district. The program is designed for educators who hold current teaching and school psychometry certification and have a minimum of 2 years of experience in PK-12 education.

As an educational administrator, your support will be critical to the success of the applicant. Your checkmarks and signature below indicate your assurance of the required elements of support to the applicant, *should they be admitted to the program*.

- The applicant has worked for at least two years in PK–12 education, and the school or district anticipates the applicant's continued employment during the program and after its completion.
- The school or district will identify a school psychology mentor/supervisor either within the district or the community.
- The school or district will provide access to assessment kits (e.g., WISC-V, WJ-IV Cog, WJ-IV Ach, BASC-3, ABAS) for learning and development as well as for use during their internship.
- The school or district will allow the applicant to accrue required practicum hours.
- The school or district will allow the applicant to accrue required Internship hours (1200 hours).
- The school or district acknowledges that the school psychology is a distinct specialty that requires focused learning and application of skills.
