

**Academic Planning: Academic Advising Graduate Certificate (AADV)**

The AADV graduate certificate can be completed within five semesters when students complete one, 3-credit hour course per semester, or in three semesters when students enroll in two, 3-credit hour courses for the first two semesters starting in the fall. Students can begin the program in the fall or spring semester.
