HOW TO REGISTER WITH DSS

STEP 1: APPLICATION

Fill out an application on our website at www.uab.edu/dss

STEP 2: DOCUMENTATION OF DISABILITY

Submit documentation from your doctor/therapist by uploading it with your application, emailing it to dss@uab.edu, or dropping it off in HSC 409.

STEP 3: ACCOMMODATION PLANNING

Once DSS has received and reviewed your application and documentation, you will be contacted to schedule an appointment.

STEP 4: ACCOMMODATION ORIENTATION

Once all documentation and eligibility requirements are met, you will attend an Accommodation Orientation either in person or through a self-guided online orientation to review your accommodations.
