Definition of Overall Level of Report:

No Report (0 Points)	A new program; an existing program undergoing curriculum change.
Developing (1-5 points)	A program with outcomes, methods and no assessment completed; incomplete assessment or assessment started, tweaking methods, need to provide more information about the assessment methods, weak discussion of results, hard to determine validity due to lack of explanation, perhaps no actions stated. Room for improvement.
Acceptable (6-10 points)	Sufficient report; has a few areas needed in clarification and/or enhancement. On the way to becoming advanced.
Exemplary (11-15 points)	Clear measures, clear process, good interpretation, and use of results, clearly closes the loop, provides evidence of seeing improvement based on analysis of results, complete report.

Assessment Report Expectations:

Programs should assess all student learning outcomes within three years.

Reports should make limited reliance on grades.

Acronyms should be clarified for reviewers who may not have discipline specific knowledge.

All spaces of the Assessment Report Template should be completed. If no data was collected, please explain. If no action was taken, please explain.
