“Introducing the new UAB Center for Addiction and Pain Prevention and Intervention (CAPPI)”



Karen Cropsey, Psy.D.

Dr. Cropsey is a clinical psychologist and professor in the department of psychiatry. She received her degree in clinical psychology from Indiana State University and completed an addiction post-doc at Virginia Commonwealth University. She was an assistant professor at Virginia Commonwealth University before joining UAB 13 years ago in psychiatry. Her clinical and research interests is in addiction focus on nicotine, alcohol and opioids, particularly in disadvantaged populations such as persons living with HIV and incarcerated people. She is the founder and co-director of the Center for Addiction and Pain Prevention and Intervention (CAPPI). The mission of CAPPI is to improve addiction and pain outcomes through research, education, patient care, and community outreach.



Burel Goodin, Ph.D.

Dr. Burel Goodin received his Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology (emphasis on Behavioral Medicine) in 2010 from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County. He then completed a postdoctoral fellowship in pain research at the University of Florida before taking an assistant professor position at UAB in 2012. Dr. Goodin is currently an associate professor with tenure in the Department of Psychology. He is the Director of the Biobehavioral Pain Research Laboratory and Co-Director of the UAB Center for Addiction and Pain Prevention and Intervention (CAPPI). His goals include: 1) bring increased attention to, and help mitigate, the pervasive disparities in the experience of pain, and 2) mentor the next generation of clinician scientists.
