

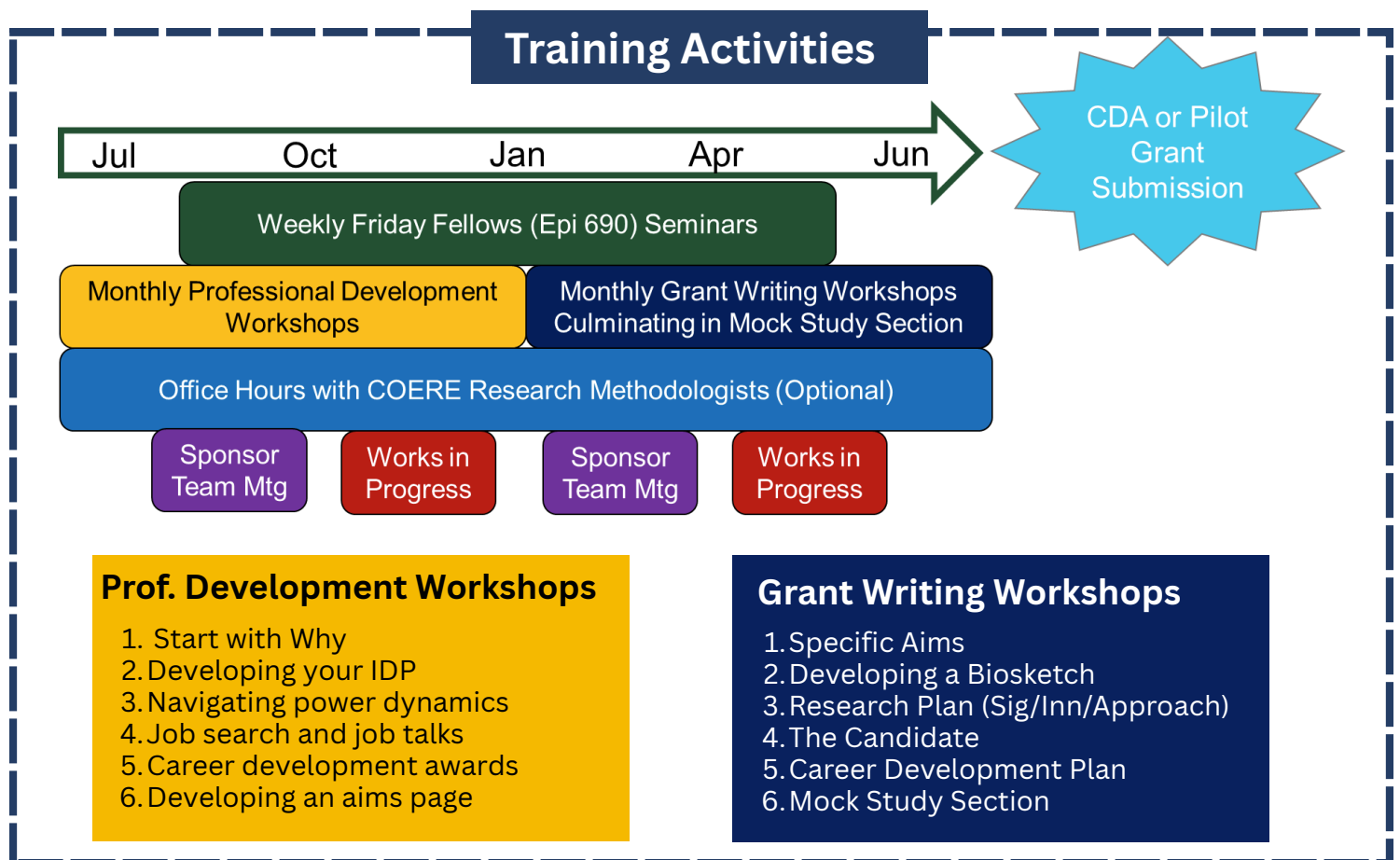

# COERE SCHOLARS

in health services and outcomes research



COERE Scholars is recruiting for the inaugural 2026-27 cohort commencing July 1, 2026 (n=6-8 slots). A new research development program, COERE Scholars, is designed for UAB postdoctoral trainees and early-stage investigators seeking training in health services and outcomes research. Training activities for this one-year program include weekly seminars, monthly workshops, biannual check-ins with sponsor teams and works-in-progress presentations, and an introduction to NIH grant writing with the goal of grant submission (see figure below). Those who achieve program participation benchmarks and submit a Career Development Award (NIH K award or equivalent) or UAB pilot grant within 6 months of program completion will receive a monetary incentive.



## Eligibility

- Must be in a postdoctoral or junior faculty status at UAB - can be in any UAB School/College.
- For clinicians, the program may be coordinated with a current residency program or clinical fellowship.
- No citizenship or permanent residency requirements.
- Applicants must have the support of their home department/division and at least 50% protected time (with salary support for that protected time) for research and COERE Scholars activities.
