# 3<sup>RD</sup> YEAR SCHEDULING LOTTERY INSTRUCTIONS HUNTSVILLE CAMPUS

## When does the lottery open and close?

Open: Wednesday, January 24, 2024 (after class meeting)

Close: Tuesday, February 13, 2024 at 8:00 am.
Schedules Posted: Thursday, February 22, 2024 by 5:00 pm.

#### What are the requirements for third year?

- Core Clerkships (40 weeks)
  - o Family Medicine (4 weeks)
  - Psychiatry (4 weeks)
  - Neurology (4 weeks)
  - o Internal Medicine (8 weeks)
  - Obstetrics-Gynecology (8 weeks)
  - Surgery (8 weeks)
  - Pediatrics (8 weeks)
- Ambulatory Acting Internship (4 weeks)—opposite Family Medicine

#### How does the lottery work?

- Each cohort of students in a track will take their clerkships in the same order.
- A cohort of students moves through the clerkship curriculum together.
- Students will submit preferences for their preferred order of clerkships.
- Each student will get a complete schedule.

## How do I enter my lottery choices?

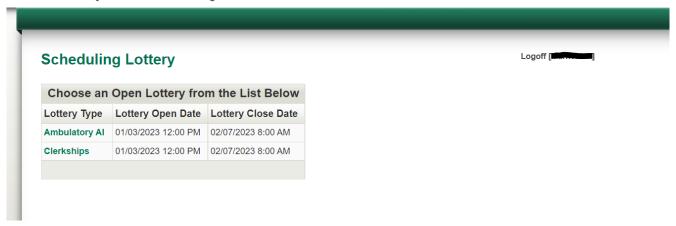
Visit: https://apps.medicine.uab.edu/students/scheduling/

1. Login in with your Blazer ID.

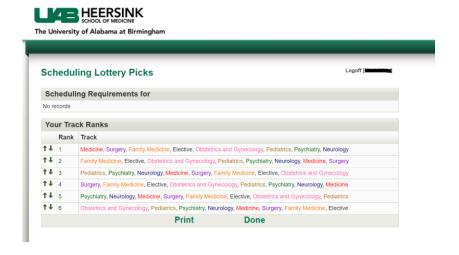


2. Choose "Clerkships".





3. Use the up/down rank tracks in the order of preference.



- 4. When finished rearranging the tracks, click Done. This saves the changes and sends an email confirming your ranking.
- 5. You may re-rank tracks as often as you like while the lottery is open.

### What if I want to change my schedule?

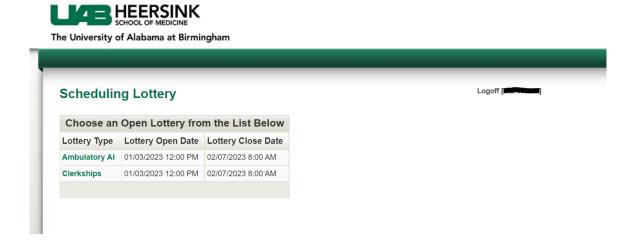
- Drop/add for clerkships begins Thursday, February 29, 2024 at 5:00 pm.
- Review the video instructions on how to request a change using OSCR.
- Include a rationale for the change.
- Requests will be reviewed in the order received. When possible, changes will be made.
- If a change is not possible now, we may be able to make changes later in the year.

## What about scheduling my Ambulatory AI or elective block?

- Students in **Huntsville** take an Ambulatory AI in place of an elective in 3<sup>rd</sup> year. The Ambulatory AI must be completed on the assigned clinical campus.
- Below is the list of Ambulatory Als offered on the **Huntsville Campus**. Click on the link to read the course descriptions. Be sure to check the course pre-requisites.
  - o 30-301 Rural Medicine Acting Internship
  - o 90-160 Dermatology
  - o 90-290 Ambulatory Internal Medicine
  - o 90-300 Acting Internship in Family Practice
  - o 90-303 Family Medicine/Sports Medicine
  - o 90-520 Ambulatory Pediatrics
  - o 90-850 Emergency Medicine
- Choosing an Ambulatory AI
  - Consider the pre-requisites
  - More options if you have Medicine/Surgery early in the year.
  - Since it has to be completed on the Huntsville campus, scheduling it in 3<sup>rd</sup> year is helpful!

#### How do I schedule my Ambulatory AI?

• After completing the clerkship lottery track picks in the Scheduling Lottery, return to the Open Lottery list and choose Ambulatory AI.



- When finished arranging your choices, click Done to save your selections.
- You will receive an email confirming your ranking.
- You may re-rank courses as often as you like while the lottery is open.
- Ambulatory AI rotations will be added to schedules on Thursday, February 22nd.
- Any drop/add requests for your Ambulatory AI or an elective can be made using the Online Schedule Change Request (OSCR) (<u>UAB Central Authentication System - CAS - Central</u> <u>Authentication Service</u>) beginning on Tuesday, April 2, 2024 at 5:00 pm.

# Things to keep in mind about the lottery and the 3<sup>rd</sup> year

- The order of clerkships does NOT
  - o Influence your ability to get into a specialty or program.
  - Predict grades
- Each course has an enrollment limit. We cannot overbook courses.
- Under compelling circumstances, it is possible to make changes to your schedule later in the year.
- You must sit for Step 1 before beginning clerkships.
