Inpatient L&D: Fellow functions as labor and delivery supervisor. Monday - Friday 7:30am - 5pm. A maternal-fetal medicine physician is available in house throughout the day.

Inpatient Antepartum Fellow: Fellow is part of a team with a faculty member to care for high-risk patients; this includes rounding on antepartum service in the AM, complicated post-partum patient, patients in ICU, and seeing any high-risk consults

Outpatient rotation: Fellow sees patients in high-risk obstetrics clinic

Ultrasound: Fellow performs ultrasounds and provides consultations regarding management of obstetric complications
