**Results:** The abstract must be uploaded by the presenting author as word document (as .docx or .doc file) during [online registration](#). The body of the abstract should not exceed **2,500 characters** (with spaces). Abstracts will only be accepted on the understanding that the work will be presented in person at the conference.
