Transplant Fellows Schedule

The Transplant Surgery clinical service line at UAB is divided into two services: Liver/HB and Kidney/Pancreas/Access. Fellows will spend 6 months of the year as the primary fellow for each service. The fellow is responsible for management of the inpatient service and consultations, assisting the attending surgeon. However, fellows are not restricted to their primary assignment. On the contrary, fellows are expected to assist on the other service as needs dictate: we have two Transplant Fellows, not one Kidney Fellow and one Liver Fellow. Additionally, on weekends, a single fellow will cover both services. Therefore, it is important to keep informed of the happenings of both services, so that clinical continuity can be maintained.

Below are listings of conferences and scheduled clinics for each service. Daily attending rounds will be scheduled at the discretion of the on-call attending surgeon. Under most circumstances, operative responsibilities will be prioritized over clinic and conference.

In addition to the service schedules listed below, there are a few monthly or quarterly events which will be attended by fellows. Each service has month Morbidity & Mortality conferences, and quarterly QAPI meetings. Fellows should attend all M&M and QAPI meetings regardless of their current service. Fellows will meet with the Division Chief at least once monthly, typically on a Friday morning at 7am over coffee.

Liver/HB Transplant Surgery Service Weekly Schedule

Elective hepatobiliary cases typically occur on Tuesday and Thursday, but may be scheduled elsewhere during the week, depending on availability. The fellow assigned to the liver service is expected to attend all clinics as the OR schedule allows, and should prioritize the Pediatric Clinic over Adult Liver Clinic on Mondays.
