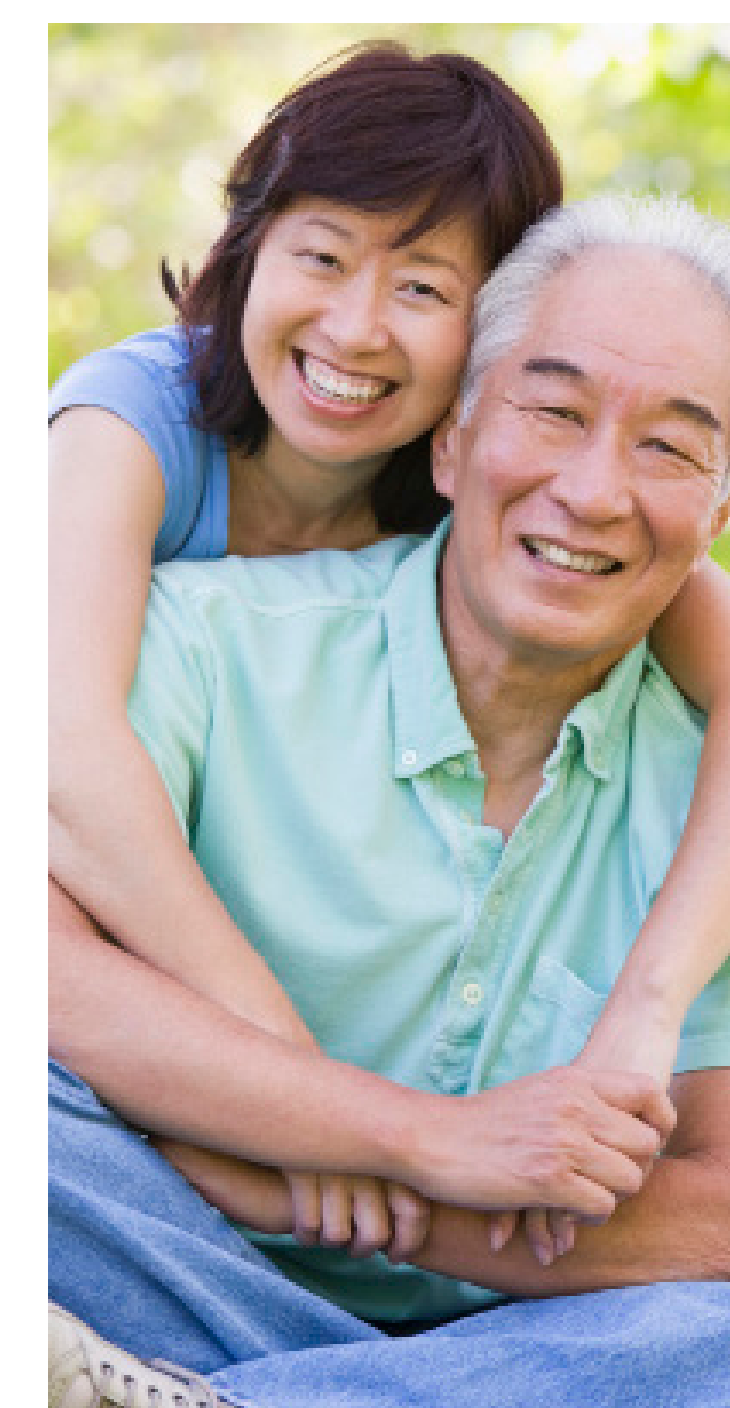


WHO WE ARE

WHAT WE DO

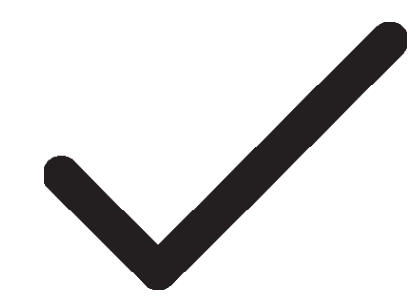
A precisely-selected, carefully screened research population is crucial to ensure accurate study outcomes and cost containment. Poorly screened subjects may result in high drop-out rates and cause subjects to be excluded, affecting sample size and power calculations and causing extended recruitment and increased costs. The RRSF connects researchers with the talent and experience needed to execute their studies.
