EMSAP Newsletter #4, November 2024

This newsletter starts where the last newsletter (#3) stopped (with the EMSAP graduation dinner in April 2023).

Fall 2023 began as usual in August with a pre-class social and seminar for EMSAP freshmen on the summer reading. The Holiday Party occurred at the Smooth Rock Conference Center in Vestavia Hills, and dermatology residents Joanne Jacobs and Kevin Yang spoke and judged our gingerbread house competition.



In January 2024, the medical school selected 36 students to interview on Zoom, the dental school selected 8, and the optometry selected 3.

Because applications increased in 2024 to the dental and optometry schools, medicine only offered admission to 17 students, 10 from Alabama and 7 from elsewhere; 12 matriculated. The dental school admitted 5 students and 4 matriculated. Optometry admitted 4 students and 2 accepted. The resulting class of 18 is strong, with 8 National Merit Finalists.

In January, a dozen EMSAP students auditioned for the Bioethics Bowl team. The final team was Abigail Haider, Hudson

O'Neil, Sree Nataraj, Eshika Kudaravalli, Bryan Preer, and Srushti. Tauluri. The team practiced twice a week with Professor Pence until the competition in April, when it competed at Baylor University in Waco, Texas. The team then also visited the Waco Mammoth National Monument (pictured).



EMSAP students continued to socialize in groups called "families" led by senior students called "mothers." They visited Top Golf, Pepper Place, Buc-ee's and went ice skating:

The 2024 EMSAP graduation dinner occurred at Aldridge Gardens in Hoover, where students heard an inspirational talk by EDSAP alumnus Alex Cruz, who returned that April from Oxford with a PhD and who then also graduated from UAB Dental School. Alex next starts a dental residency at Harvard. At this dinner, EMSAP teaching awards went to Jared Taylor in Neurosciences and Braden McFarland in Cancer Biology:
