10 WHEREAS the temperature during different weather seasons has not been routinely adjusted; and

12 WHEREAS routinely adjusting the temperature promotes a comfortable classroom environment that is  
13 conducive to effective learning; and

15 WHEREAS Facilities Management has agreed to maintain appropriate Chemistry Building temperatures  
16 throughout the year.

19 supports the Facilities Management's decision to maintain appropriate Chemistry Building temperatures

23 of the chemistry building to the management of UAB facilities through an online maintenance work order
