

How to Burn a CD

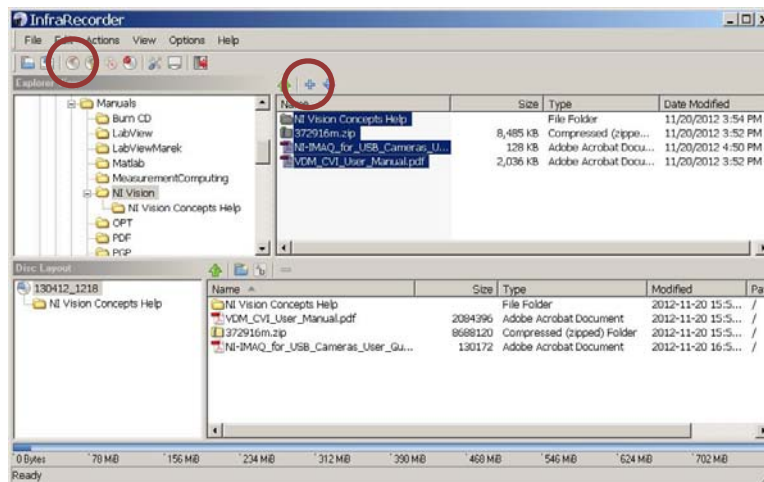
Start InfraExpress. Click Start Menu --> All Programs and find InfraExpress in folder InfraRecorder.

Click Create Data CD in the InfraExpress pop-up box. Make sure you have a blank disc in the CD drive. If you don't have a CD, the Module can provide one for you. Ask Vincenzo.

If a pop-up message titled 'Question' appears, click NO



In InfraRecorder, the top part of the window is the browser that allows you to view and select the existing files and directories, and the bottom part (Disc Layout) is the list of files and directories you are about to burn. The Disc Layout is empty at first, and to add files to the disc, select the files in the browser (top portion), and click Add button marked as a '+' sign. You can select a single file or directory or multiple at once.



Once all files/directories are selected, click Burn button marked as a small disc image in the top menu. That brings Burn Compilation window up. Make sure Simulation checkbox is not marked. Click OK. Burning can take few seconds up to a couple of minutes, depending on the size of the data files you are burning.

Once burning is complete, click OK button. To make sure the CD was burned correctly, you can check the content of the CD in My Computer
